

CHILE: Assassination Attempt

The wounding of the Chilean Supreme Court President on Friday by terrorists highlights a major vulnerability of the Pinochet regime. The assailants probably were members of the Movement of the Revolutionary Left [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The terrorists may hope to create an atmosphere of insecurity, thus undermining the foreign business confidence that underlies the economic prosperity of the country. The security services will probably react strongly, particularly if they think the foreign diplomatic or business communities could be affected. [REDACTED]
