3. DURING AN INFORMAL MEETING IN AN AIRPORT COFFEE SHOP, THEY TALKED ABOUT THE INVASION OF HAITI AND EXPLAINED THAT THE PLAN WOULD BE TO SEIZE POWER BY USING THE MEN ALREADY INFILTRATED BY ROLANDO MASFERRER ROJAS. DURING THE FIGHTING, TWO OR THREE AIR RAIDS WOULD TAKE PLACE WITH THE PLANES WHICH WERE ALREADY IN THE UNITED STATES.

[REDACTED] FOUR AIRCRAFT WERE IN NEW JERSEY [REDACTED] WHICH WERE AVAILABLE FOR USE IN THE HAITIAN INVASION.) THE MEN SAID THAT SUCH AIR RAIDS "ALREADY HAVE BEEN AUTHORIZED." THE CUBANS, TOGETHER WITH THE HAITIAN EXILES, WERE TO TAKE CHARGE OF THE SITUATION. LATER THEY WOULD ATTACK CUBA AND THEN THE UNITED STATES WOULD BE FORCED TO INTERVENE IN THE CASE.
