1. [REDACTED] Chancellor Adenauer [REDACTED] to give an account of the Government's preparations for the Berlin Conference. [REDACTED] the Chancellor returned to his old practice of reading long extracts from commentaries appearing in the newspapers. The Chancellor reportedly also expressed views on the conference which differed with those of his advisor, Professor Wilhelm Grewe. At one point, the Chancellor quarreled with the refugee spokesman, CDU Bundestag member Linus Kather.
2. [REDACTED] in discussing this meeting, indicated that, in his opinion, the Inter-Ministerial Committee on the Berlin Conference was "dead".
