It does not appear that the position of the Federation of Yugoslav Journalists in respect to the receipt of relief funds is prejudiced by the non-existence of a Yugoslav National Committee recognized by NCFE. NCFE makes available to the existing National Committees only very small amounts for relief purposes to be used to alleviate acute cases of distress of an emergency character. Consequently, a Yugoslav National Committee would have a small sum for meeting extraordinary cases of distress, but would not be able to make a monthly allocation of funds to the Federation of Yugoslav Journalists for the relief of its members suffering hardships.

Insofar as the extension of assistance to emigre intellectuals through their employment on research work is concerned, the NCFE has been employing Yugoslavs for this purpose on the same basis as other exiles.

While the State Department has objected to the extension of financial assistance to the newspaper put out by Milan Pouric of this organization, there would seem to be no reason why NCFE should not afford relief to worthy Yugoslavs in cases of acute destitution.
