WALKER, John Anthony, Jr.

1. On 20 May 1985 Special Agent (SA) "Jay" Aldhizer, FBI Liaison, advised that on the evening of 19 May 1985, the FBI arrested John Anthony Walker, Jr., in Maryland on charges of espionage for the Soviet Union. Walker is a retired Navy warrant officer and currently is employed as a private investigator in the Norfolk, Virginia, area. The FBI confiscated over 100 classified documents from Walker at the time of the arrest, the majority of which were Navy and Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) communications. Relative to Walker's possession of the classified documents, the FBI is anticipating additional arrests in the near future and is presently trying to hold the lid on any publicity. According to the FBI, Walker's son is presently serving aboard the USS Nimitz. [REDACTED]

2. Office of Security subject file records are negative in the name of John Anthony Walker, Jr., and no references appear to be identical with the exception of a negative response to an FBI name trace on 10 April 1985 concerning John Anthony Walker, Jr., aka: Arthur James Walker (OS/NR), born on 28 July 1937. [REDACTED]

3. SA Aldhizer advised that he would be informing the Counterintelligence (CI) Staff of the Directorate of Operations. He further stated that this case will probably turn into a major espionage investigation having many tentacles inasmuch as classified communications are involved. [REDACTED]
