Prior to interview, you should review appropriate files, such as your file entitled "Cuban Intelligence Activities," and you should canvass Agents handling Cuban investigations to develop any matters which should be covered in the interview. For example, [redacted] may have information of interest concerning Rundquist-Shergalis case. (C)

Promptly advise Bureau results of interview and incorporate any pertinent data furnished by [redacted] in form suitable for dissemination under appropriate captions.
