a. There was no restriction on the use of electricity in Hanoi.

b. On 12 August the Long Bien Bridge was bombed and destroyed.

d. [REDACTED] Hung Yen Province, South of Hanoi, [REDACTED] peasants, almost all of them women or children, were working the land in broad daylight in spite of continuous and intense air activity overhead.

e. There were no signs of a food shortage.

f. All industrial plants had been evacuated from urban areas. The 38 spinning plant outside of Hanoi was running at 20 percent of its original capacity.

[REDACTED] several missiles mounted on mobile frames being transported at night. Unguarded missiles [REDACTED] parked on roads. [REDACTED] almost all the missile launchers [REDACTED] in North Vietnam are mobile.

[REDACTED] Haiphong Harbor was filled with British, Italian, Greek and Chinese Communist freighters. [REDACTED] trucks from East Germany, tank trucks from Poland and repair trucks from Rumania being unloaded. [REDACTED] that if Haiphong Port were attacked, North Vietnam would suffer greatly.
