

Although the minimum Japanese demands are not yet clear, the Chinese might have to apologize publicly, a step that is probably not acceptable. In late 1980, the Chinese party journal *Hongqi* admitted general errors in party-to-party dealings during the Cultural Revolution; Chairman Miyamoto at that time labeled the admission "important" but clearly indicated the need for more specific confessions. At this point the Chinese party is anxious to broaden its international connections but may be unwilling to go much further than accepting major differences in policy. The Japanese will probe the Chinese position further at the Yugoslav Party Congress in June, which the two parties reportedly have been invited to attend. [REDACTED]
