AT A MEETING OF PROMINENT CUBAN EXILE LEADERS HELD IN NEW YORK CITY IN MID-OCTOBER 1963 IT WAS AGREED THAT SEVERAL PROMINENT CUBAN EXILE GROUPS WOULD GIVE FINANCIAL AND MATERIAL SUPPORT TO GENERAL MIGUEL ANGEL RAMIREZ ALCANTARA, PRESIDENT OF THE PARTIDO NACIONALISTA REVOLUCIONARIO DOMINICANO (PNRD, DOMINICAN NATIONAL REVOLUTIONARY PARTY) IN ORDER THAT HE COULD SUCCESSFULLY LEAD A COUNTER COUP TO TOPPLE THE NEWLY-ESTABLISHED DOMINICAN TRIUMVIRATE. THE SUPPORT PLEDGED BY THE EXILES INCLUDES MILITARY HARDWARE, MONIES, AND PERSONNEL IN RETURN FOR DOMINICAN SUPPORT TO THE CUBAN

23 OCTOBER FOR SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO, WITH TRAVEL PLANS TO TAKE HIM
TO THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC IN ORDER TO MEET WITH [REDACTED] AND TO
COORDINATE DETAILS OF THE CUBAN EXILE SUPPORT.
