An unidentified Haitian [REDACTED] and an unidentified Haitian [REDACTED] were expected to arrive in Miami on 22 September 1964 in an effort to recruit Cuban exiles who would be willing to go to Haiti to fight for the overthrow of Haitian dictator Francois Duvalier. Those persons willing to fight would then leave Miami immediately for an encampment in New Jersey. It is believed that this encampment has been set up by Cuban exile leader Rolando Arcadio Masferrer Rojas and that almost all of the prospective recruits belong to Masferrer's group.
2. According to [REDACTED] was believed to have arrived in Miami by 22 September accompanied by another unidentified Haitian. Both were believed to have come to Miami to arrange final details as regards the Haitian problem. [REDACTED] also said that it was possible that Masferrer would come to Miami to have an interview with the visiting Haitians.
