THE BOSNIAN GOVERNMENT ALSO CLAIMS BOSNIAN SERBS PLAN TO KILL 100 TO 200 MUSLIMS, CONSIGN A LARGE NUMBER TO FORCED LABOR IN BOSNIA, AND SEND A LESSER NUMBER TO WORK IN SERBIA. FOREIGN MINISTER SACIRBEY, AS WELL AS REFUGEES EVACUATED FROM SREBRENICA TO GOVERNMENT-CONTROLLED AREAS, CLAIM THE BOSNIAN SERBS HAVE COMMITTED MURDER AND RAPE. [REDACTED]

SREBRENICA EVACUATION ALMOST COMPLETED

DUTCH TROOPS SAID LAST NIGHT THAT ONLY 2,500 CIVILIANS REMAINED AT THE UN COMPOUND AT POTOCARI AND FEW IF ANY IN THE REST OF THE ENCLAVE, ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS. PRIME MINISTER SILAJDZIC TOLD THE PRESS LAST NIGHT THAT 14,000 HAD REACHED BOSNIAN GOVERNMENT-HELD TERRITORY.

-- PRESS REPORTS YESTERDAY SAID THE SERBS WERE HOLDING AN UNKNOWN NUMBER OF MILITARY-AGE MALES AT THE FOOTBALL STADIUM IN BRATUNAC.

-- PRESS REPORTS INDICATE THAT BOSNIAN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS HAVE BEEN DIRECTING INCOMING CIVILIANS TO THE AIRPORT INSTEAD OF PLACING THEM IN TEMPORARY HOUSING. HOUSING THE REFUGEES AT THE AIRPORT WOULD GIVE THE GOVERNMENT LEVERAGE TO REQUEST THAT IT BE OPENED TO RELIEF FLIGHTS BUT WOULD LEAVE THE EVACUEES VULNERABLE TO BOSNIAN SERB SHELLING. [REDACTED]

PRESS REPORTS SAY THE BOSNIAN SERBS ALLOWED AN AID CONVOY INTO SREBRENICA YESTERDAY AFTER BLOCKING IT ON WEDNESDAY. [REDACTED]

BOSNIAN GOVERNMENT'S AMBIVALENCE GROWS

EVEN BEFORE THE EVENTS IN SREBRENICA, THE GOVERNMENT HAD NOTIFIED THE UN IT WAS REASSESSING THE VALUE OF ITS PRESENCE. NOW, PRESIDENT IZETBEGOVIC HAS SAID PUBLICLY HIS GOVERNMENT MOST LIKELY WILL ASK THE UN TO LEAVE NO LATER THAN NOVEMBER, WHEN ITS MANDATE EXPIRES.

-- IN THE MEANTIME, HE WILL MAXIMIZE PRESSURE ON THE UN TO USE ITS PEACEKEEPING FORCE IN BEHALF OF GOVERNMENT INTERESTS.

-- THE FORCE'S ROLE IN KEEPING INTERNATIONAL ATTENTION FOCUSED ON CREATING A JUST PEACE SETTLEMENT AND MEETING HUMANITARIAN NEEDS WILL BE PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT TO THE GOVERNMENT IF IT CANNOT OPEN OR MAINTAIN A SUPPLY CORRIDOR TO SARAJEVO.



-- IZETBEGOVIC'S DECISION ON WITHDRAWAL WILL DEPEND IN PART ON HIS TALKS WITH CROATIAN PRESIDENT TUDJMAN NEXT WEEK ON MILITARY COOPERATION. TUDJMAN HAS THREATENED TO EXPEL THE UN FROM CROATIA IN NOVEMBER. [REDACTED]

THE GOVERNMENT MIGHT ASK THE UN TO WITHDRAW IN THE VERY NEAR TERM IF:

-- IT JUDGES THAT WASHINGTON IS COMMITTED TO LIFTING THE ARMS EMBARGO AGAINST IT AND TO USING AIRSTRIKES AGAINST THE SERBS. BOSNIAN PRIME MINISTER SILAJDZIC'S RECENT VISIT TO WASHINGTON FOCUSED ON THESE ISSUES. [REDACTED]

-- UN FORCES TRY TO IMPEDE BOSNIAN ARMY OFFENSIVE OPERATIONS, PARTICULARLY AROUND SARAJEVO, OR ITS EFFORTS TO OBTAIN ARMS. [REDACTED]
