1991 THE VIETNAMESE GOVERNMENT IS EXTREMELY CONCERNED ABOUT RECENT
PRESS ACCOUNTS REPORTING SOVIET KGB INTERROGATION OF U.S. PRISONERS
OF WAR (POW) AFTER 1975. THE PRESS REPORTS INDICATE SOME U.S.
PRISONERS WERE FLOWN TO THE SOVIET UNION BETWEEN 1975 AND 1978 TO BE
INTERROGATED WHILE OTHERS WERE INTERROGATED IN VIETNAM.

2. [REDACTED] THE VIETNAMESE GOVERNMENT IS CONCERNED THAT THE REPORTS WILL UNDERMINE THE CREDIBILITY OF VIETNAMESE ASSERTIONS THAT ALL U.S. SERVICEMEN WERE RETURNED TO THE UNITED STATES AT THE END OF THE VIETNAM WAR. HE SAID THE GOVERNMENT BELIEVES THE CURRENT INTERNATIONAL POLITICAL ATMOSPHERE IS SUCH THAT KGB ASSERTIONS ARE MORE LIKELY TO BE BELIEVED THAN VIETNAMESE DENIALS.

3. [REDACTED] THERE IS ALSO SOME CONCERN AMONG OFFICIALS OF THE VIETNAMESE GOVERNMENT THAT THE KGB ASSERTIONS COULD CONTAIN SOME ELEMENTS OF TRUTH. UPON HEARING PRESS REPORTS OF THE KGB CLAIMS, VIETNAMESE AMBASSADOR TO THE UNITED NATIONS TRINH XUAN ((LANG)) SENT A MESSAGE TO THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE IN HANOI INQUIRING IF THERE WAS ANY TRUTH TO THE REPORTS. AS OF 12 DECEMBER, THE MINISTRY HAD NOT SPECIFICALLY RESPONDED TO LANG'S QUERY.

[REDACTED] COMMENT: RECENT ARTICLES IN THE PRESS REPORT THAT OLEG D. KALUGIN, ADVISER TO THE CHIEF OF SOVIET INTER-REPUBLIC SECURITY SERVICE VADIM BAKATIN AND FORMER KGB GENERAL, SAID IN AN INTERVIEW FOR AN AUSTRALIAN TELEVISION PROGRAM THAT HE HEADED AN INTERROGATION TEAM IN VIETNAM FROM 1975 TO 1978 THAT QUESTIONED AMERICANS. ACCORDING TO THE ARTICLES, SOVIET AGENTS INTERVIEWED FOR THE PROGRAM CLAIM THAT OTHER AMERICANS WERE FLOWN TO THE SOVIET UNION FOR QUESTIONING BY SOVIET AGENTS AND MAY HAVE BEEN KILLED AFTER BEING RETURNED TO THE VIETNAMESE.)
