1. During September and October 1952 discussions continued in the Federal Chancellery on the establishment of a new intelligence agency out of the old GEHLEN organization.




These discussions continued to be conducted behind closed doors and included invariably such persons as General GEHLEN, von LOSSOW, Ministerialrat GUMPPEL, Ministerialdirektor GLOBKE, Ministerialrat Dr. Wilhelm GRAU, and as of late another GEHLEN representative identified as Herr ECK. At the present time no written statements have been formulated on the progress or outcome of these meetings. However, the date of 1 April 1953 was named as the beginning of the fiscal year for the new organization. As of this date the organization will be subsidized by Federal funds alone.
