Threat: Widespread Israeli-Palestinian confrontation



Meanwhile, Palestinian rejectionist groups are striving to make clear their continued opposition to any form of Palestinian normalization with Israel. Islamic Resistance Movement (HAMAS) founder and spiritual leader Yasin this week reiterated his threat that the use of force was the only way to properly liberate Palestine, and members from other rejectionist groups denounced both the Oslo Accords and the existence of the state of Israel at a recent rally—attended by 1,000 supporters—in Gaza.
