ACTIVITIES: (TJ-812807) 1. 29 APR, THE 203RD DISTRICT COMMITTEE IN THE  
VICINITY OF RUMU RBR 1 SOUTHEAST OF PHNOMPENH INSTRUCTED CADRE NEAN OF AN  
UNIDENTIFIED UNIT IN THE VICINITY OF KOMPONG CHHNANG: "IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE  
INSTRUCTION FROM UNIT 870, THE DISTRICT COMMITTEE HAS DECIDED TO HOLD A  
MEETING 5 MAY. THE CADRES AT THE BRIGADE AND REGIMENT LEVELS ARE INVITED TO  
ATTEND THE MEETING ON TIME. IT IS OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO INVITE THE SECRETARY OF  
THE REGIMENT HQS TO ATTEND A MEETING ON THE AFTERNOON OF 4 MAY."  
(TJ-812797) 2. 16 APRIL 1000, UNIDENTIFIED CAMBODIAN COMMUNIST UNIT (832)  
TO UNIDENTIFIED CAMBODIAN COMMUNIST UNIT (607): TO 8: THE PRESENT SITUATION  
IS NOW MAKING A SPEEDY CHANGE, AND PHNOM PENH IS GOING TO FALL INTO OUR HANDS.  
THEREFORE, THE ENEMY TROOPS IN ALL PROVINCES HAVE NO OTHER CHOICE EXCEPT TO  
SURRENDER. (SIGNED BY 7) (E) 3. 18 APRIL 1100, UNIDENTIFIED  
CAMBODIAN COMMUNIST UNIT (7C) TO UNIDENTIFIED CAMBODIAN COMMUNIST UNIT (3D):  
TO SE: 1. IF THE ENEMY TROOPS DO NOT SURRENDER, ATTACK THEM FIERCELY; IF THEY  
LAY DOWN THEIR ARMS, LET THEM COME OUT OF THEIR POSITIONS, AND SEARCH THEM  
THOROUGHLY FOR HIDDEN ARMS SO AS TO AVOID ANY POSSIBLE INCIDENT. 2. IN ORDER  
TO AVOID CONFUSION, KEEP THE WAR PRISONERS IN A SEPARATE PLACE, AND THE  
REFUGEES IN THE CIVILIAN HOUSES, AND TRY TO SOLVE THEIR LIVING PROBLEMS. IF WE  
ARE GOING TO BORROW THINGS FROM THE VICILIANS, IT IS THE BEST WAY TO GIVE  
THEM BACK WITHIN A MONTH. EXPLAIN THE SITUATION TO THE CIVILIANS. AS TO THE  
MATTER OF CLOTHING, URGE THE CIVILIANS TO BE PATIENT FOR THE TIME BEING, AND  
WE WILL TRY OUR BEST TO SOLVE SUCH PROBLEM FOR THEM. DO NOT KEEP THE REFUGEES  
IN THE DENSE JUNGLES SO AS TO AVOID ANY AILMENT CAUSED BY THE DAMP WEATHER OF  
THE JUNGLE. (SIGNED BY 15) (E) 4. 14 APRIL 1600, UNIDENTIFIED  
CAMBODIAN COMMUNIST UNIT (405) TO UNIDENTIFIED CAMBODIAN COMMUNIST UNIT (175):  
THE SITUATION AT KG CHIAM: FROM THE EVENING OF 11 APRIL TO THE MORNING OF 12  
APRIL, OUR TROOPS ATTACKED THE ENEMY'S POSITION AT MERIK. KILLED 22 ENEMY  
TROOPS, CAPTURED SOME OF THEM, WOUNDED ONE SERGEANT, AND CAPTURED TWO MACHINE  
GUNS, CARBINES, AND SOME AMMUNITION. THIS POSITION IS AT FIVE KILOMETERS NORTH  
OF THE AIRPORT. AT PRESENT OUR TROOPS MOVE FORWARD CONTINUOUSLY. (E)  
5. 21 APRIL 1600, UNIDENTIFIED CAMBODIAN COMMUNIST UNIT (FOK) TO  
UNIDENTIFIED CAMBODIAN COMMUNIST UNIT (MOC): 1) CONCERNING THE MATTER OF  
REPATRIATION OF THE FOREIGNERS, WE HAVE CAPTURED ONE SHIP. YOU ARE EXPECTED TO  
COME HERE TO RESOLVE THE MATTER. 2) OUR TROOPS HAVE DECIDED TO REPAIR THE  
RAILWAY FROM SIHANOUK TO VEAL RENH WITHIN 15 DAYS. THE ROAD WILL BE OPEN TO  
TRAFFIC AFTER WE HAVE THE ROAD FIXED UP. THE TROOPS OF NGUYEN VAN THIEU HAVE  
ATTACKED KAMPOT. THEY ARE NOW ENCOUNTERING OUR TROOPS. 4) TEN ENEMY WARSHIPS  
HAVE SURRENDERED TO US. (E) B. CAMBODIAN ARMY ACTIVITIES: NOTHING TO  
REPORT.
