








NOTE

( USSR: Last night the Soviet unmanned lunar probe--Luna 21--soft landed on the moon after orbiting it for about three days. Luna 21 was launched from Tyuratam on 8 January and apparently carried a self-propelled rover vehicle similar to Lunokhod-1, which was placed on the moon in November 1970. Shortly after the probe landed, the new rover vehicle began transmitting pictures back to earth, including a relief of Lenin and a view of the lunar horizon. Lunokhod-1 operated on the moon for more than ten months, during which it traversed about six nautical miles, sending back pictures and conducting scientific experiments. [REDACTED] )
