Doctor John asked me, as his authorized defense counsel <sup>for</sup> to inform you about the following: (Doctor John has, of course, assumed that he would be acquitted and would have personally informed the appropriate American officers that during his captivity with the Soviet Secret Service, he has not given any significant intelligence information pertaining to the organization, persons, or connections of the American Intelligence Service or its relationship with German officials to the Soviet Secret Service or the East German State Security Service.

He would appreciate your confirmation of this letter.
