~~Top Secret~~*Developments***FRANCE: Pressing for Action in Rwanda**

Paris is trying to build international support for its proposed intervention in Rwanda despite a disappointing response from its European allies, according to press reports. [redacted] Secretary General Boutros-Ghali has urged the UN Security Council to approve the plan, and various sources indicate it is likely to do so.

— The French Ambassador to Rwanda is visiting neighboring African capitals to seek support, and the French military claims that Senegal and Ghana have agreed to provide contingents. [redacted]

— The Western European Union meets today to consider support for intervention. *France's allies are not likely to provide troops but may offer money and logistic help to underwrite the operation.*

— The French military asked [redacted] yesterday for US help in caring for the refugees once safehavens have been secured. [redacted]

Over the weekend, Rome appears to have backed off its decision to send troops, [redacted] the Italians now claim that they need UN authorization to participate.

— Italian Army officers reportedly are still planning to send a 450-man unit if authorized by the government. [redacted]
