Problems With Rwanda Airlift, OAU

The French say materiel necessary to mount the relief operation is piling up in the Central African Republic and they are likely to ask for US help,

[redacted]

— They have complained [redacted] about the "unreliable" Russian crews of the three An-124 aircraft they chartered to bring in equipment from France and estimate that they must move at least an additional 100 tons per day to eastern Zaire. *The shortfall, however, is likely to abate once the task force is fully deployed unless the French become deeply involved in the distribution of relief supplies.*

— Belgium, Germany, the Netherlands, Portugal, and Spain will provide airlift assistance or relief supplies, according to press reports. *The demands of peacekeeping operations elsewhere and the need for frequent maintenance of their few, aging transport aircraft, however, will limit them.* [redacted]
