
RWANDA:

New Government Declared, French Still Worried

The Rwandan Patriotic Front, which declared itself the country's only legitimate government on Tuesday, is working with Hutus to form a multiethnic coalition. Press reports say the RPF has named Hutu moderate Faustin Twagiramungu as prime minister; he would have been prime minister under the never-implemented 1993 Arusha peace accord. *The RPF will be hard pressed, however, to find other Hutu moderates willing to support an RPF-led government.*

— RPF military leader Kagame claims the new government will be guided by the power-sharing principles of the Arusha agreement, but the RPF says it will bar members of the Hutu ruling party and groups believed to be responsible for massacres.

— RPF officials claim they will declare a unilateral cease-fire once they are confident they can defend their areas of control.
