

SUBJECT: Transmission of the Draft Report for Senator Quayle [redacted]

1. On behalf of my co-chairman (Dr. Eimer) and myself, I am transmitting the draft Executive Branch report to the Congress regarding CBW verification. This report is intended to satisfy Senator Quayle's amendment. [redacted]

2. We have taken this subject and this report as far as we are able. The document has been through review in the Executive Branch several times and every change was made which we could understand and meaningfully incorporate. Material not agreed is marked with brackets, i.e.:

- Page 6 of report;
- Page 7 of report; and,
- Page 2 of Annex A.

It is our view that further work on this report, to be most useful, should be managed by the NSC Staff. We will conform the text, of course, as required. A final version will be printed off and copied for the Congress. [redacted]

3. The Department of State reported formally that they were unable to complete their review of this document. A copy of their declaration was sent to you earlier. [redacted]

4. It seems to us that the next step is for State and for ACDA to create a transmittal letter from the President to the Congressional leadership. Of course, any disagreed material has to be harmonized. [redacted]
