1. On behalf of my Co-Chairman of the Analysis Group (Dr. Fred Eimer), I have attached the final version of the Executive Summary, Annex A, and Annex C for your last comments. (Annex B is the SCI-level annex and has not changed since no additional comments were received.) This final version incorporates your previous comments and includes a new annex -- Annex C -- which is based on your contributions. [redacted]

2. As you recall, the Quayle Amendment to the 1985 DoD Authorization Bill states that it is the sense of the Congress that the President submit a report identifying and evaluating the following:

- Existing and planned programs to support verification requirements necessary to determine compliance with the 1972 Biological and Toxin Weapons Convention and a chemical weapons ban.
- The budget resources necessary to support verification requirements necessary to determine compliance with the 1972 Biological and Toxin Weapons Convention and a chemical weapons ban. [redacted]
