1. When the news of the latest invasion in Oriente Province by Cuban exiles was released, it was received by those who do not sympathize with the government with mixed emotions. [Redacted] the invasion was not of sufficient importance to encourage the people to act in support of the invaders. The majority of people [Redacted] regarding the landing party wanted to see the invaders succeed in establishing guerrilla warfare, but they were apathetic to the point that they would not do anything to support the invaders unless they knew it was a sure thing. Most [Redacted] were people who planned to leave Cuba and the only thing that they were concerned about, [Redacted] was to avoid any problems that could interfere with their chances of leaving the country legally. These people, [Redacted] would do anything demanded by the GOC in order to get out of Cuba.
2. [Redacted] the only time that the Cuban people will have enough guts to revolt against the GOC is when they know that several large size landing parties are attacking different areas of the country in a coordinated manner. They and only then, will they do something. In the meantime, those who do not sympathize with the GOC and are planning to leave the country are only concerned with saving their own skin, because, through the years they have been psychologically conditioned to avoid problems with the regime.
