SPECIFIC Newsprint - Request for 1,000,000 Sheets

1. LINCOLN is currently planning to publish a one-sheet "liberation" newspaper approximately ten(10) days before D-day, or prior to that if target country should close down the independent press. - The "liberation" paper would become a joint effort of CEUA, CEUAGE, and FAGE and would be printed in Honduras, El Salvador, or at Headquarters.

2. For purposes of clandestine distribution the paper stock used should be strong, thin, and lightweight. The ideal dimensions would probably be about 18 inches by 24 inches. The trade term for this strong, thin, lightweight paper is not known to LINCOLN, but it is similar to onion or rice paper.

3. It is requested that Headquarters procure 1,000,000 sheets of this paper in order to have it on hand in case of immediate need.

However, partial procurement could be accomplished in 3 days.

1. The request in reference would require several weeks to procure. Available material is termed MANIFOLD paper 9lbs, Chemical Wood White, and comes in sheets of 34" x 44". ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Headquarters has the facilities for cutting such sheets in half to 17" x 22" size. The ^{estimated} ~~required~~ 500,000 sheets would weight approximately 30,000 pounds.

2. In view of the above facts, it is suggested that Lincoln make a specific request indicating; ^{a.} ~~the points to which such material would be shipped;~~ points to which such material should be shipped to be held in readiness, ^{b.} ~~the~~ estimated amount needed at each point, ^{c.} ~~the~~ time elements involved, d. Lincoln arrangements/~~and/or~~ ^{facilities} support, or plans for publication in the areas cited, e. Headquarters ~~actions~~ in addition to procurement of the paper, which will be required by Lincoln (mats, ink, etc.)

3. Proper formulation of plans at this ~~stx~~ time will assure Headquarters' ability to supply the necessary support to Lincoln when ~~and/or~~ the need occurs.
