PERSONS INVOLVED: [ ] and Esterline and [ ]

DISCUSSION:

Discussion related to [ ] 846.

Esterline mentioned that he had been in a meeting most of the morning over matters in LINC 609. Nothing further on that.

[ ] said that the man they had suggested to work for the first person should be held up. They should get in touch with him and keep him (this referred to SEEKFORD.)

[ ] said that we had never really known how far SEEKFORD had really gone. Subject discussed in referenced document requires immediate action - is of the highest precedence.

Mention was made that the rest of the information had been brought up to us (PIVALL being inferred).

[ ] was being used as a courier to bring this info to Esterline though he was not aware of the contents of the pouch which he was carrying (Esterline said he didn't know what it was about either). Esterline was requested to meet [ ] and relieve him of the pouch. It was added that LINC 612 explained the contents of the pouch.

It was indicated that SEEKFORD was needed in Washington where they could talk to him and check things. This was stressed.

[ ] spoke with Esterline and asked to have [ ] call as soon as possible.
