SUBJECT : Conversation with [ ] Concerning  
Guatemalan Plans for OAS Conference

1. In a conversation with [ ] this morning, he commented that he was talking to the Colombian Ambassador, Zuleta ANGEL, yesterday. The Ambassador said that he had gotten a telephone call the night before from the Colombian representative in Guatemala, a Senor ORDUZ (phonetic). He told the Ambassador in double talk that he was very concerned about information he had picked up that the Guatemalans had certain evidence that they are going to use at the OAS Conference. The Ambassador instructed ORDUZ, if he considered it sufficiently important, to catch a plane and come to Washington. He is doing so and will arrive in Washington tonight.

2. Mr. [ ] stated that he had informed Mr. GEBERICH, the Colombian desk officer at State, re this conversation.
