Memorandum for the Record

1. Mr. Frank Schroeder, of the staff of the Immigration Subcommittee of the Senate Judiciary Committee, informed me that the Committee has an "agent" who has performed very good services for them, and who Schroeder has arranged to have sent on private financing to Guatemala. He should arrive in Guatemala this week.

2. Schroeder stated that the man was quite brave and foolhardy and had at one time killed a man. He was, therefore, afraid for his agent's safety. For this reason, and with the thought that we might keep an eye on him, he has furnished me with the agent's name, which is []

3. [] allegedly has extremely close contacts with certain people in Latin America through Batista in Cuba. Schroeder has promised to make available to us any information which [] produces in Guatemala. It may be that we may wish to inform our station chief in Guatemala on a Restricted basis as to who [] is in case he should start wandering around Guatemala.

4. It would be of some interest to know also how good a man [] might be.
