- On 29 October 1953 C
C stated that within a short time an organization known as the ~~Sociedad~~ Sociedad de Amigos de Guatemala would be formed in Mexico. This organization would sponsor meetings for the purpose of informing the Mexican people of the fact that Guatemala is the victim of aggression on the part of imperialistic American companies and is threatened with invasion by another Central American country. SAINZ added that Guatemalan newspapermen and writers would be sent to Mexico to participate in these meetings.
- A three-page manifesto denouncing American aggression in Guatemala has already been prepared. It is to be used to arouse interest in the proposed organization and to gain adherents to it.
- The first meeting of the Sociedad de Amigos de Guatemala was scheduled to take place in Mexico City during the week of 1-7 November 1953.
