1. Re your report dated 4 May:

a) The gist of paras 2, 6, 7 and 11 is being transmitted to CALLIGERIS.

b) Your para 4: Please keep us informed about the further development of these arrests and court cases.

c) Your para 11: We understand that a limited amount of the papers printed in WSHOOFS reaches you now by pouch and that our friends there are making renewed efforts to transport more papers by smuggling routes as well.

2. Re your report dated 5 May:

a) Your para 3: Thanks for the stationery. We appreciate the difficulties involved in obtaining it. Naturally, blanks could be used directly while we have to reproduce sheets which are already written on - but we know that it is far more difficult to get blanks. Whenever possible, let us have more samples of stationery, envelopes, rubber stamps, etc: they will come in very handy.

b) Your para 4: We have already replied to your - or rather ESSENCE's - comments on SHERWOOD by separate dispatch.

c) Your paras 5 - 6: We understand that there will be only 3 delegates from Guatemala to the SUMMIT congress (and have asked you by cable to transmit their names and addresses). We are advising CALLIGERIS in the same sense. We agree with your comments on the desirable relationship between delegates from Guatemala and

d) Your para 8: We have approved the very apt idea of the lapel buttons in the meantime.
