Supplement to S-6

Supplement to Sab Instructions for target "CHET Bridge" (ADAM Support).

CHET Bridge is constructed of two I Beams which measure 24" x 12" x 3/4". These rest upon concrete abutments and a concrete center support. To destroy this bridge thirty blocks of TNT should be placed upon each of the I beams in the manner shown in the sketch and photo. The charges should be placed just off from the center concrete support so that when they cut the I beams the section of the bridge will fall. The charges should be connected together in series and fired by means of an electric blasting machine simultaneously. In the event that the electric system fails, non-electric detonators should be employed and fused so that they fire as nearly as possible at the same time.

Team can work either from a boat or better from the bridge itself. The approach to the bridge is recommended from the North (from the village of MORAN). There is considerable activity in the form of fishing, etc. during the night and care must be taken to avoid detection.
