Transmittal of Agent Radio Gear

REF: A. LINC 2393; B. [ ] 987

1. Enclosed herewith are two RS-1's each with supplementary gear intended for use of the resident radio operator serving SEMANTIC as per Reference A. Reference B, not sent to Guatemala, indicates that additional gear was pouched on 7 May to Guatemala from the [ ] The gear from [ ] should include a radio signal plan complete with crypto pads and crystals.

2. It would be appreciated if the Station RO would check all sets for workability, check for sterility including removal of fingerprints, repack separately by major item using local Guatemalan materials, and hold for LINC cable instructions to deliver to agent via the BSKINCID-BSCOBILLA-SEMANTIC mechanism. The radio signal plan should be rechecked for sterility and packed separately from either of the RS-1's.

3. It would be appreciated if the Station RO would procure and pack in addition about two hundred feet of fine black enameled copper wire, say number thirty, and modern electrical fittings which will match modern electrical outlets. It will be noted that Latin style outlets have already been furnished.

4. A copy of the specific operational plan covering the RRO in discussion will be forwarded you at a later date. Agents PRQ with photo is being forwarded under separate cover. It is suggested that you copy the radio signal plan as received from [ ] With the foregoing data you will be in a position to monitor the activities of agent in your area should it be desirable.
