1. Information such as that contained in the reference cable is of little value except in the sense that it provides an operational lead. In the future it is requested that efforts be made to follow up on such reports, not only through [ ] himself, but through other sources with government and Army connections. [ ] should be asked to provide specific details. For instance; who was his friend?, why does he make the statement that the government is moving out inhabitants of the area?, what proof does he have that the area is guarded?, and how does he know that large boxes are arriving? [ ] should request his informant to furnish a detailed account of his trip.

2. The station should place evaluations on all reports and cables. In this instance, of course, the appraisal of content would simply reflect whether [ ] actually made such statements. Your comments as to the likelihood of such activities really taking place are also welcomed, but these should be clearly indicated as such.
