1. A question has been raised regarding the security implications of GUAT 375. Information from Headquarters points out that Colonel Glass considers L] unreliable, dangerous and a "snake," and that L] is the only officer Colonel Glass has so categorized. It is possible, however, that the latter's personal relationship with L] may have colored his evaluation.
2. LINCOLN stated, in reply to the foregoing information, that it is proceeding to probe and develop L] according to findings in the field within the K-Program and that if PAGE is satisfied and no other adverse information is developed, eventual unification of L]'s assets with SYNCARP is contemplated. LINCOLN does not feel prepared to accept the personal views of Colonel Glass who has been away from the target country for a long time and may have a personal dislike for L]
3. LINCOLN submits the foregoing for your information in dealing with L]
