Death Notices

1. LINCOLN was aware that you had run a "death notice" operation in the past.
2. This operation would be useful again, right now. Only, we would like to have the death notices announce the deaths of ARBENZ, Mrs. ARBENZ, FORTUNY, GUTIERREZ, PELLEGER, Jaime ROSENBERG, Alfredo GUERRA Borges, Jaime DIAZ Rozzotto, Humberto GONZALEZ Juarez, Francisco MORAZAN and others of their ilk, rather than the deaths of foreign Communists. The date of death should, in each case, be listed as October 1954, with convenient variations as to the specific day of the month.
3. The cards should be sent to the "victims" themselves, to crypto-Communists and pro-Government politicians, to the newspapers, to the radio stations and to a small scattering of prominent, but not politically exposed, citizens. It is not necessary for all the addressees to get the same cards; indeed, it will be better if addressees start comparing, like stamp collectors, which ones they have.
4. Please advise if your assets and the current heavy burdens on them permit taking on this assignment, and whether you feel it would have sufficient results to warrant the diversion of time and energy from other activities. Advise also whether you wish LINCOLN to attempt to secure reproductions of the sample cards you have forwarded or whether you will be able to secure sufficient cards (perhaps 500 in all) for your purposes.
