MEMO FOR COL. KING

SUBJECT: SS Springfjord

1. [ ] phoned this morning to tell me that Loftus Becker, State Department Legal Counsellor had phoned on Friday and indicated that he had been tied up and unable to do anything about the Springfjord case. Becker said, however, that he had been pushed again by the New York attorneys representing the claimants, and feels that the Department should take some action. Becker said that he will be in New York all this week, but upon his return will initiate action in the Department.
2. Becker said he had not read [ ] memo on the case which expressed reservations on State Department representations to the Guatemalan Govt on the matter.
3. [ ] suggests that you discuss the matter with Assistant Secretary Rubottom this week prior to Becker's return, so that a mutual position on the case can be worked out in order to avoid having the matter get out of hand in the Department.
