LEADERS ON AUG 6 WHICH WILL PERMIT EARLY "DISCOVERY" GREY BOOKLET DOCS.

E. STATED [] WILL NOT RETURN WSBURNT UNTIL 16 AUG.
SAID HE NEEDED HIM BADLY DURING CURRENT PERIOD REORGANIZATION.
