SUBJECT : Summary of Material from RO's 1700 26 June to 1100 27 June

1. A message from CASTILLO through RO-40, located near Chiquimula, at 1100 26 June, requested that there be an immediate air attack on troops coming toward Quetzaltepeque from Ipala. At 1500 CASTILLO sent an urgent request for an air drop of supplies and rifles at Vado Mondo.
2. Reporting through RO-22 at 0930 26 June CASTILLO asked the FCP not to forget the aerial observation of troops moving from Jutiapa to Ipala. He said that there would be little bombardment of Zacapa on 26 June, and added that the enemy has many reinforcements and modern equipment. RO-22 was advised by the FCP at 0310 27 June that 60 men arriving by way of Jocotan are opposition troops.
3. There were no reports from other operators. All times are EDT.
