SPECIFIC SS ALFHEM and Other Relevant Matters

RYBAT PBSUCCESS

1. The following information was received from [] in a cable on 27 May and is passed to you for your information:

On the afternoon of 26 May the Captain of the SS ALFHEM sent a message saying that the ship would arrive in Antilla, Cuba, on 30 May 1954. (Source: AMBOCEPTOR, B-2).

[] 2. On 24 May, 1954, your Headquarters received a message from [] which stated that the KUBARK station there had been advised of the following by the ODOATH DIO:

- a. Per instructions of ODACID, ODOATH air patrols are conducting a search of the following area for ships carrying arms: Gulf of Paria to Yucatan Channel, including all passages and channels of Windward and Leeward Islands, and Mona and Windward Passages. They are also patrolling the Eastern coast of Costa Rica.
- b. The DIO further states that he hopes to put one submarine in the Honduran Bay and another in the Honduran Gulf. However, these submarines are not yet in place.
- c. There will be no patrols conducted along the west coast of Central America.

The cable from [] then advised that JAGUAR will make a thorough check of TYRA TORN when it docks in []
