MEMO: On Command Posts

I. There will be two command posts in the field.

- A. The general CP, consisting of  
Pancho  
The Major  
G1, G-2, G-3, G-4  
Don Ricardo, Juan Jose, Manuel

The 4 section should consist of a message center (couriers to [ ] see para 4) and a section to keep books on tactical logistical deployment (see 2nd memo on drops). ]

B. The advanced CP, consisting of Col. Fox, Exec, G-1, 2, 3, and 4, RO + Cryptographer, plus a protective platoon of 20 rifles, 10 Smgs, will travel with the HANK group.

II. The above accomplishes two purposes:

- A. Separates the two possible leaders for preservation purposes  
B. Boosts morale of men by having one leader committed alongside.

III. The advanced CP would assume full command in the event of abortion of the plan of forward movement of Pancho's CP less DR, JJ, M, & RO's as outlined in para V.

IV. The general command post will be formed as follows:

A. On D-5 the present command post should be depleted of gear, the advanced command post moving to the HANK staging area.

On this date Pancho and Staff will depart on the much-publicized trip to other Central and South American countries for the purpose of "Summoning aid and solidifying anti-communist forces". On this date, Phillipe will depart for [ ] Don Ricardo for [ ]

By this date, a farm near [ ] or a safe house in [ ] (probably the one selected for the incoming radio operators sent by ABE) will have been stocked for a 10 day stay by 20 people to serve as the general C.P.

B. Pancho and entourage will be pulled during the layover at [ ] (after 1 day in [ ] and with Don Ricardo will reenter [ ] on approx D-2 to assemble at the safe house above.

V. When Mingo reports (verified by PEPE) that Aurora has been secured and the capital city is under tactical control, and ABE authorizes by radio, Pancho will proceed to the Cessna 180 flown by Mister X from Toncontin and will land at Aurora to a reception party set up by Mingo. Here the command radio is the one formerly utilized by Mingo.
