1. Information contained in References contain all info developed ^{YET} on Subject A of Ref C [Karel PEILIKER], who per Ref F reported in US as of May 18.

2. Note somewhat odd last sentence of cable quoted para 8 Ref E. ["Mail slow in arriving. Have written many letters. Am securing office around Times Square ready continue our business to success."], and

para 6 Ref. E. ["6. As indicated in the referenced [] dispatches the TRES LEQES firm appears to be transacting business with Prague and Warsaw, consistent with its being in the refrigerating business. However that may be, in view of the resemblance between the "Tres. Concos" of "Caixa Postal 472" and the "I. T. Trealiries" of Rio de Janeiro and the TRES LEQES firm which is located in both Rio and Sao Paulo, it would seem possible that the TRES LEQES firm may have been the sender and addressee of all the mail and the cables." (The postman doubtless copied the names wrong).]

3. KUSODA has taken no action since 21 April. Because KUSODA ODENVY overburdened, hesitate ask them undertake 24-hour surveillance or other most full-scale inquiries in re Subject, unless need seems clear.

4. Has LINCOLN any info re Subject since REFE Ref A, any strong opinion

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pro or con asking KUSUDA conduct further inquiries?

[In view of the facts that (a) LINCOLN has made no mention of PEILIKER since Jan 21, and (b) [] and FBI have plenty of other work to do, I suggest we should keep this cable pitched in a minor key and leave it to LINCOLN to press, if they see fit, for further action by SSD and FBI.

We might ask [] by cable to try to find out whether the "American engineer" for whom S. BOLANOS works in Cosamaloapan, Vera Cruz, is PEILIKER, and whether he seems to have a bona fide business there?]

END OF MESSAGE

Ref D indicates that one S. BOLANOS, with whom PEILIKER has corresponded, used to be a waiter at the American Club in Mexico City, which PEILIKER has given as an address. BOLANOS is now reported to be working in Cosamaloapan, Vera Cruz, "for an American engineer", --quite possibly PEILIKER?

Ref F indicates that Felix Vigna, with whom PEILIKER has corresponded, is a Mexico City firm which sells Italian tiles, mosaic works and Italian pistols, shotguns, carbines and ammunition, --which fits in with PEILIKER's January offer of "arms and ammo" to CALLIGERIS. Vigna is now in Italy.

Ref D indicates that Antonio VALLADARES Aycanema, through whom the *January* approach to CALLIGERIS was made, has been a Guat exile in Mexico since 1960, where he "represents certain Guat firms in Mexico for the purchase of machinery and related materials" and is "reported to be a contact of the Military Attache of the local Guat Embassy."

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
