SUBJECT: General - Operational  
Specific - Termination of JUVIAS.

REF: [ ]1046; LINC 3077.

1. In an effort to clarify and successfully terminate relationship between JUVIA II and ERRATIC the following report is submitted. The urgency of [ ]1046 was based on a development JUVIA II thought might endanger his life, his desire for extrication from this relationship, and the inability of [ ] to determine when JUVIA II might be subjected to physical danger.

2. Upon receipt of LINC 3077 whose authorization of flight offers an escape for JUVIA II, the importance of time has lessened and for that reason LINC 3077 is hereby answered by dispatch. This means of communication has also been chosen to give as complete and thorough report as possible of this problem.

3. At the outset undersigned would like to assure LINCOLN of impartiality, and desire to complete this termination in a manner becoming to KUBARK and UNSUCCESS. PURWELL has been present at all meetings between JUVIA, JUVIA II and RENNELL and therefore is able to give a complete account of what has transpired.

4. In an effort to accurately report the existing situation JUVIA II was contacted 25 May 1954 and asked the following questions:

A. Exactly what commitments have you made to ERRATIC and in whose name were they made?

Answer: "Through medium of LAS I have assured ERRATIC sufficient financial assistance to participate in a revolution against SERRANT. I also implied that while our organization did not wish to provide him arms it would do so if necessary, without specifically mentioning PBPRIE Government its participation was implied. At no time was any specific PBPRIE organization mentioned as the actual backers of the LAS."

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B. At the present moment what does ERRATIC expect from you and the Group you represent?

Answer: "ERRATIC expects sufficient financial assistance and arms for his followers to take part in a revolt against the WSBUNT Government."

C. Are you willing to break off contact with ERRATIC by telling him your Group can not provide the promised assistance or because he requested immediate assistance which the Group could not provide?

Answer: "No, because of danger from ERRATIC's followers, the loss of my personal integrity, the effect on my position in [ ] and my conviction that since I entered this operation to help your Group, I feel they have the responsibility to provide a more justifiable method of termination."

D. What actual danger do you think exists for you because of your present relationship with ERRATIC?

Answer: "Several times already ERRATIC has advised me that his principal followers have warned him against giving me further information because they felt they were being "betrayed" and "played for suckers". Furthermore, there have been two instances of suspiciously sudden and unexplainable transfers of Guatemalan officers, who are working for ERRATIC, from Guatemala City to remote "little Siberia" posts. After each of these instances ERRATIC told me that his Advisers arrived for a hystorical all-night session in which he was severely criticized for revealing to me the secrets of his organization. Although his presentation to me of these facts was toned down, it was undoubtedly given as a veiled threat. Furthermore, he told us that Lavilla-Cordeva, the well-known torture victim of the ARELINZ regime, is now stationed in [ ], charged with the job of investigating me. It is impossible for me to say when one of these men might decide to take action against me, but as the E-Day for any action by CALLIGERIS draws nearer the chances will increase."

"Regardless of the present position in which I find myself, I would not hesitate to offer my services in any operation to benefit the foreign policy of PERHINE, or to rid this hemisphere of the Communist threat. In this present operation, however, initial decision to risk the safety of my and my standing in [ ] might have been different had I known that I would be dealing with a group which you belatedly advise is thoroughly penetrated by Communists." (The last statement is in reference to LINC 2386 where [ ] was authorized to mention the Communist penetration of the ERRATIC group.)

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5. As JUVIA II refuses to terminate relationship with ERRATIC per Para 4 C, the existing situation is as follows:

- A. JUVIA II continues to talk to ERRATIC and stall when the latter insists upon meetings.
- B. ERRATIC still feels that assistance is forthcoming and is getting increasingly persistent as he sees the CALLIGERIS movement increasing in stature.
- C. JUVIA II feels ERRATIC followers might interpret his continued stalling and the increased assistance to CALLIGERIS as a betrayal by him and take violent action against him.
- D. [ ] is unable and unwilling to predict when and what action might be taken by ERRATIC followers.
- E. Since early April JUVIA II has asked to be cutout from this contact in a manner which will protect his family, business position and personal integrity.
- F. As JUVIA II entered this relationship at request of [ ] and for benefit of PBPRIME, he feels entitled to removal in a manner which is satisfactory to him.

6. PURWELL's comments:

- A. Since early April JUVIA II has asked for nothing except a cutout or some other means of termination in keeping with his involvement.
- B. By LINCOLN continuing to ignore requests for a cutout or some other type of termination, [ ] is and has been placed in a very embarrassing position for the past six weeks.
- C. Regardless of misinterpretations and misunderstandings between [ ] and LINCOLN, both have the responsibility of extricating JUVIA II.
- D. The absence of any constructive suggestions from LINCOLN as how to extricate JUVIA II has caused [ ] to lose the respect of JUVIA and JUVIA II and if allowed to continue might cause embarrassment to all concerned.
- E. The undersigned wishes only to help extricate JUVIA and JUVIA II from this position. [ ] remains completely cooperative with PBSUCCESS and LINCOLN and has attempted to remain impartial to conflicts and personalities involved in FT/11.

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F. The most plausible and acceptable solution to JUVIA and JUVIA II is to have someone contact ERRATIC as a Senior Representative of the LAS, inform ERRATIC that JUVIA II was only a cutout and proceed on whatever basis LINCOLN wishes.

7. In summation the undersigned feels KUBARK has the obligation to attempt termination of FT/II in a manner satisfactory to JUVIA and JUVIA II, who have been the innocent victims in this case and who have, for six weeks, requested only some other method to terminate their relationship as they do not consider the one ordered by LINCOLN to be plausible. The urgency of past messages was to call to LINCOLN's attention the impasse that exists locally with the danger and repercussions to PBSUCCESS, [ ] and KUBARK if JUVIA II is the victim of violence from ERRATIC followers.
