1. A report from Guatemala states that the subject made the comment on 17 May that he had brought back \$5,000 from CALLIGERIS or the CALLIGERIS organization. It is requested that you query CALLIGERIS with respect to this matter. In the reference it was stated that CALLIGERIS had been advised to have no further dealings with the subject.

2. [] also said that he is worried about the possibility that there are Focke-Wulf planes in Guatemala, inasmuch as he is going to "lead flights over Honduras when the time comes". Reports of such planes, accompanied by Czech pilots, continue to be received in Guatemala, but all investigations have been negative. Local pilots are stated to be greatly perturbed and incensed over the reports. Several have been heard to protest that no foreign pilots are needed.
