MEMORANDUM FOR DEPUTY DIRECTOR, PLANS

SUBJECT: Special Funds Request

As you will have seen from my memorandum on our 28 April meeting with Ambassadors Peurifoy and Willauer, they propose \$10,000 and \$5,000 respectively to be held by the respective [ ] for the use of the Ambassadors for protection of U. S. officials and appropriate American citizens in the event of disorder.

Because I believe that we must take every step along these lines (you will have seen my arms requisition for the two embassies), I am forwarding this with my recommendation for your approval.

We discussed the appropriateness of the Ambassadors obtaining such funds from the department but ruled out this procedure on grounds of security and administrative complications.
