SUBJECT :

Documents for Ambassador Willauer

The following documents have been forwarded to Ambassador Willauer so that they may be included in the Honduran White Paper on Guatemalan Communist interference in Honduran affairs:

- a. The 1954 work plan by Honduran Communists in Guatemala. The plan specifically calls for Guatemalan Communist guidance and coordination of Honduran Communist activities. It is signed by Antonio LUNA, Rodolfo D. LOPEZ, and Rigoberto PADILLA.
- b. A letter to Manuel GUTIERREZ from LOMBARDO Toledano regarding the Guatemalan UFCO strike and asking that GUTIERREZ pass \$200 to a confidant in Honduras to support the UFCO strike there.
- c. Several cables between the Honduran strike committee and the CNCG asking economic aid from Guatemala.
- d. A document indicating that the Guatemalan Ambassador in Tegucigalpa had been ordered to supply specific items of intelligence on Honduras.
- e. Several documents showing that the Guatemalan Embassy in Tegucigalpa and the Consulate in San Pedro Sula clearly were engaged in intelligence operations. Certain Honduran, Guatemalan and Costa Rican sources and areas of operations are given.
- f. Several documents showing that Guatemalan diplomatic officials in Tegucigalpa were hostile toward CARIAS and VALENZUELA and had little enthusiasm for GALVEZ, who paradoxically in one report is described as heading a Communist-style government. Colonel PINEDA, obviously a military source of information for the Guatemalan Ambassador, is shown to have been helpful to the Guatemalans.
