Received from George PRATT the sum of \$50,000 in dollar notes of \$500 denomination, being the June and July instalments of \$25,000 each for the tripartite subvention of French trade-union activity.

It is understood that this money will be sent to France and that any benefit of exchange by which the dollar notes are exchanged for more than 1,000,000 francs per instalment will accrue and be used for the general purposes of the subvention project which are :

- (a) to aid the trade-unions in their efforts to assist workers to escape the reléve,
- (b) to aid the trade-unions in their efforts to organize and establish contacts and channels of communication between workers who have been forced to go to Germany and trade union organization in France.

It is also understood that when available, a report will be furnished as to the delivery and distribution of the money and, of course, reports will be made of any other information which is developed in the operation of this project.
