




Bolivia-Peru: *Narcoavion* Case Exposes Official Drug Ties

The 4.2 metric tons of finished cocaine seized by Peruvian counternarcotics authorities aboard a Bolivian DC-6 at Lima airport on 15 September was the largest cocaine bust ever for either Bolivia or Peru. According to local press reporting, the aircraft—registered to Aerolinas Bolivianas Sociedad (Aerobol)—departed from El Alto airport in La Paz, Bolivia, and had scheduled stops in Lima, Peru, and in Guayaquil, Ecuador, and was to end its flight in Mexicali, Mexico. The cocaine was packed in more than 100 wooden crates bearing the inspection seals of Bolivia's Special Antinarcotics Police (FELCN).




Narcoavion Flight Route
