1. Thank you for the envelope for 7499.
2. I have noted your remarks regarding "comfort parcels" for Corn's collaborators and 7404 and myself are fully in agreement with your decision to authorise Beaver to spend up to 2,000 Kr. for this purpose.
3. Thank you for the further information regarding the material picked up by the Swedish fishermen.
4. In accordance with your suggestion, I am writing to H.Q. to ask them when we can expect the contact plan mentioned in their D.629 of October 15th.

GREEP OPERATIONS

1. It is regretted that there was some delay in sending you details of GREEP 34 - our D.694 of 15th Nov. - and GREEP 29 and 36 - our D.700 of 15th Nov. This was entirely due to the fact that the whole Section has been engaged upon a very important Exercise, but you should have no cause for complaint on this score in future.
2. In our telegram of 19th Nov. we stated that we could explain the difference in the total number of bags received by you, and the number referred to in our D.700 of 15th Nov.
3. It is now no longer possible for us to send GREEP material by rail to Scotland; everything has to be sent by road, which only takes place once a week. There is no guarantee that they are able to despatch from Scotland all the packages that are lying there ready for forwarding, but of course they always send as many as possible. It would not help if we were to ask Scotland to inform us the exact number they had been able to despatch, as in this case it would be impossible to get a letter in the bag in time.
4. We think, therefore, it will be better for us, whenever we send material from London to Scotland, to inform you at once exactly what has been sent. When these packages eventually arrive at your place you will already have been notified as to the numbers of the packages, their contents and to whom they should be sent in the Field.
