Please find enclosed herewith my accounts for JANUARY, 1945. I regret that I have had to pay out Kr. 900.00 to D.H.T. in excess of their maximum subsidy of Kr. 12000.00. When KRAFT was down to start them off with a clean sheet, he discovered that there were old debts amounting to this figure, and in response to his appeal, I agreed that we would help them out so that they could make a clean start. He said that they hoped that the time would not be far distant when they would be able to manage with less than the Kr. 12000.00 which we are paying out now. Incidentally, for your information, he has lodged Kr. 9000.00 with me, which sum is to be regarded as a special reserve for D.H.T. operating from this town.

2. You will note that there is a fairly heavy item for fetching the CREEP bags which you send down. Although I have not mentioned it, this item of Kr. 126.00 also includes portorage. You have not seen an item like this before, because the Consulate were standing these charges. Now they think it a trifle too steep, not un-naturally, seeing that they only get one or sometimes two bags themselves.
