Your Memo. No. 38 regarding 4342. It is quite correct that 7448 did not give 4342 instructions to proceed to Stockholm. I gave them to him! I saw him on the morning of January 11th and told him to get busy with the authorities so that he could travel in the evening. He was to come up to me and report whether everything was set so that I could wire you to expect him. He came up and said that he would have to go through all the usual rigmarole and I therefore wired you accordingly as per tel. No. 0352. Meantime I left no doubt in his mind that he was to report to Friggagatan as soon as he could, and they would fix up the appointment with you. This is what you said when you were down here. I am afraid that I felt that it was up to the Danes to cope with him, and I regarded the fact that you did not react to Par. B. of my wire, as a sign that I need not worry any more about him. Sorry, slicker service next time!

2. Your Tel. No. 501 Par. A. I presume that no comment is expected from me since I do not know anything about the contents of your Tel. No. 013 to H. Q.
