CREEP

My D.1870 of 29th November, 1944.

1. It has now been found that the weekly Creep telegram does not give a true picture of the Creep situation. Several new factors have emerged and it will be necessary to make certain amendments, which are submitted herewith for your approval:

2. We are now handling a greatly increased amount of material through Garrick and the Camel Route; it will therefore be both advantageous and necessary for Garrick to send us a weekly summary by telegram similar to that sent by 7408. This telegram will be repeated to you.

3. It will be necessary to allot references for material obtained locally, and the following references are submitted for your approval:

(a) Creep T. This reference will cover material drawn from the Twinkle stock-pile. You will be advised by letter of the type, destination and amount of the material drawn. There will, of course, always be cases where we draw against your specific instructions.

(b) Creep Z. Local purchases, such as valves, compasses etc., will be covered by this reference.

4. It is suggested that the reference Creep F. should be used for material to be Creeped in for Operation Fordwick, and it would greatly simplify our records if you would adopt the symbol "Creep F." in all your correspondence concerning stores for Fordwick.

5. I should be glad to have your views on these suggested amendments.
